100% SAFETY GLASSES**

You probably just read a weekly tool box topic about safety glasses and here is another one.

It's that important. We can no longer leave the decision of whether or not to wear safety glasses up to someone else. Even if the General Contractor running your site does not call for them it won't matter. Eye injuries can be a serious, even life changing event and we must do our best to protect ourselves. Wearing your Safety Glasses should be second nature just like wearing your work boots, don't walk onto a site without having them on.

Effective immediately APG is 100% SAFETY GLASSES. Don't freak out, there are stipulations.

**WHERE and WHEN you should be wearing your glasses:**

Construction sites: (This includes all Groups)

- ✓ While any underground work is taking place.
- ✓ While any rough-in (In wall or Overhead) is taking place.
- ✓ Any above ceiling work.
- ✓ Demolition and Remodel work.
- ✓ Anytime you have to have your hard hat on.

Other than Construction sites:

- ✓ Any above ceiling work.
- ✓ Any confined space work.
- ✓ Any rework job.

Exceptions:

- ✓ Soft ceilings have gone in and GC allows hard hats to be removed.
- ✓ Service Techs involved with customers.
- ✓ Any existing facility in operation that does not allow PPE to be worn in public areas.

While there will always be different types of situations, it's always best to err on the side of caution. If you have to question it, you should just put them on.

Recently we have gone to a new pair of glasses, which should make this easier on everyone. There can be no more excuses as to why you're not wearing the proper PPE.
